## KATJA FARIN Growth in Absence

curated by Silvia Bignami and Giorgio Zanchetti

ERA Gallery, the new space dedicated to contemporary art by Patrizia Tenti, presents the Los Angeles artist Katja Farin for the first time in Europe in a double solo exhibition curated by Silvia Bignami and Giorgio Zanchetti:

- Katja Farin, *Growth in Absence*, MIART international fair of modern and contemporary art in Milan, 17-19 September 2021, preview 16 September (by invitation only).
- Katja Farin, solo show, Era Gallery, via Palermo 1-5, Milan, inauguration: 15 September 2021, 10 am-7.30pm.

For the opening of Era Gallery Patrizia Tenti has chosen a young artist from Los Angeles, who is exhibiting for the first time in Europe: **Katja Farin**.

In the spaces of via Palermo there are works that document her work starting from some cycles made in recent years (*Carry, Carries, Carried 2019, Lines From Arguments 2020*), up to the new **Growth in Absence** series - created specifically for Milan - which is also the heart of the Miart stand.

Through painting and drawing KF investigates issues related to the social construction of gender identity, isolation and relationships between people, staging compositions in which figures and environments are integrated through color and the use of decorative pattern.

As Ashton Cooper wrote in "Artforum": "Her figures embody the repetitive (and often inexplicable) gestures, poses and movements that make up the identity of a relationship." ("Artforum", Critic's Pick, https://www.artforum.com/picks/katja-farin-80778). It is starting from an awareness of his own means and from a visual, and properly historical-artistic, not indifferent culture that KF structures the energetic immediacy of her compositions. The figures, often androgynous or not classifiable according to gender, are representations of emotions and the possibility of communicating them. The characters who interact - or who limit themselves to silently sharing a common everyday space - in these paintings do not give life to a story, nor are they portrayed clearly individualized; they are rather the vehicles of an emotional situation, the actors of a social performance in which any sentiment, whether positive or negative, can find space. In Growth in Absence Katja Farin tells how the change that all of us have gone through involves a loss but also a possibility of growth:
